

July 15, 2010
Special Meeting

The Clear Lake City Council met in special session as the Planning Commission on Thursday, July 15, 2010, at 6:30 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Municipal Building with Mayor Gordon Lee presiding. Those present were Mike Corothers, Darrell Halse, Jamie Hintz, Scottie Hagen and Carey Holt. Absent was Jimmy Giesel, Jr. Also present were Valerie Lundquist, Don Ebbers, City Building Inspector Rodney Kannas, and Luke Muller from First District Association of Local Governments.

The agenda for this special meeting was presented for review. Motion by Hagen, with a second to the motion, to approve the agenda as presented. All voted yes. Motion carried. The Assistant Finance Officer was directed to post the agenda.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

At 6:35 p.m. Robert Schmidt, representing the Deuel County Amateur Radio Club, met with the council to discuss working together with the City to provide Internet service to the City Park during the camping season. The Deuel County Amateur Radio Club would furnish necessary equipment needed to provide Internet service in the City Park, together with installation and ongoing maintenance free of charge. They would also cover the monthly Internet service fee for the remainder of July. The Radio Club is asking the City to provide a suitable place for mounting the equipment, and cover the Internet service fees for the remainder of this camping season, and future camping seasons, approximately May 1 – October 1 of each year. During the off season, the equipment would be removed by the Radio Club for safekeeping. Motion by Corothers, with a second to the motion, to work with the Deuel County Amateur Radio Club to provide Internet service to the City Park. All voted yes. Motion carried.

Luke Muller of First District Association of Local Governments, reviewed proposed zoning maps for the City, discussed revisions to the city's comprehensive zoning law plan and updated the group on the progress to date. Discussion followed.

Motion by Holt, with a second to the motion, to adjourn. All voted yes. Motion carried.
