POSITION SUMMARY

Directly responsible to the Pool Manager for the safety of patrons and maintenance of facility.

NATURE OF WORK

Work involves long hours in the sun and heat.

Work involves using cleaning chemicals and agents.

Work involves record keeping and/or bookwork.

Work involves exchanging money.

Must work effectively with the public in a professional and friendly manner in person and on the telephone.

Must be safety conscious.

Must be able to enforce facility rules and policies, and impose discipline according to policy as needed.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Responsible for monitoring patron's safety.

Must understand pool and city policies, procedures and emergency action plans.

Must provide emergency care at your training level calmly, effectively, and professionally.

Responsible for enforcing facility rules and policies.

Responsible for maintaining a neat clean facility at all times.

Responsible for selling concessions and handling admission money.

NECESSARY QUALIFICATIONS

Need to be at least 15 years old.

Have current American Red Cross Certificate of Completion for Lifeguarding, First Aid, CPR and AED.

Ability to lift 50 pounds, bend, reach, pull and push items, including pool vacuum hose and pole, be able to climb to heights of the guard chair.

Ability to present ideas clearly, especially orally, in order to enforce pool rules.

Ability to maintain effective working relationships with employees and the general public.

Able to work mornings, afternoons, nights, weekends and holidays as needed.

Able to work in hot or cold weather conditions.
