

The Clear Lake City Council met as the Local Review Board on Monday, March 15, 2021, at 6:30 PM in the Conference Room of the Municipal Building with Mayor Gary Eide presiding. Those present were Alderwoman Lisa Lundberg, Rose Mack, Aldermen Carey Holt, John Keimig, and Harry Mewherter. Alderwoman Kelli Bauman was present via teleconference. Also present were Christa Bittner and Ryan Thomas. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Motion by Keimig, seconded by Mack to approve the agenda with the removal of the warrants. All voted aye. Motion carried.

No Clear Lake residents contested their property taxes in 2021. The board reviewed the 2021 property assessments with no suggested changes.

Motion by Mewherter, seconded by Holt to adjourn as the Local Review Board. All voted aye. Motion carried.

The Clear Lake City Council convened as regular Council.

No one appeared for public voice.

The Second Reading of Ordinance #600, amending Cows, Goats, Horses, and Sheep in the City was completed. Motion by Lundberg, seconded by Mewherter to approve Ordinance #600. Upon roll-call vote; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Jordan Likness was unable to attend the meeting, but was called to discuss the senior event being held in the Community Center. Motion by Keimig, seconded by Holt to allow the school the rent the room at half price for the event. Upon roll call vote; all voted yes.

No warrants were presented, due to lack of invoices.

Motion by Mewherter, seconded by Holt to approve the City Election Board, consisting of Nancy Barondeau, Fay Buchholtz and Barb Schiefelbein, and paying them \$20/hr. Upon roll call vote; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Mewherter, seconded by Mack to approve the Building Permit for Maynard's Food Center liquor store addition. Upon roll call vote; all voted yes. Motion carried.

Motion by Holt, seconded by Mewherter to approve the temporary liquor license for the Clear Lake Golf Club for a wedding on April 10, 2021. Upon roll call vote; all voted yes. Motion carried. (Temporary One-Day Permits are subject to all paperwork being signed and submitted to the Finance Officer and that the applicants provide the city with proof of liability insurance for the event.)

Finance Officer, Bittner, stated the District Meeting Zoom call will be held March 16th and 5:30 PM. She also mentioned the Governor designated April 2nd & April 5th holidays for the Easter weekend. The City Office will be closed those dates.

There being no further business, motion by Keimig, seconded by Bauman to adjourn at 6:42 PM. All voted aye. Motion carried.
